Subject: - Education-Technical-Examination Wing- Diploma Examination in Engineering /Technology/ Commercial practice (Revision '03 and Revision 2006), Certificate Examination in Textile Technology October-November 2009- regarding.

1. It is hereby notified that the Diploma Examination in Engineering/ Technology/ Commercial Practice (Revision 2003, and Revision 2006) and Certificate Examination in Textile Technology **October-November 2009** will commence from the Third week of **October 2009**.
- 1.1 As per G.O(MS)No:169/08/HEdn dated 11/12/08 the failed candidates under revised scheme and Rev:97 scheme can apply for the equivalent subjects under Rev:2003 scheme. The list of equivalent subjects is available in the web site **tekerala.org** under the subtitle "Govt. order". Such candidates who apply for equivalent subjects should submit application in the separate Application form prescribed (see web site) along with copies of mark lists of previous appearances.
2. All the Polytechnic Colleges in the State of Kerala (Government/Aided/Self financing) are the examination centers. (The details of Centers with Center code are given in **Appendix I**)
3. The Principals of Polytechnics will be the Chief Superintendents for the conduct of the Examination and they should accept the Chief Superintendent ship and will not be exempted from this work on any account.
- 3.1 A candidate will be permitted to register for the 5th semester exam if and only if he/she has passed all the subjects of combined 1st & 2nd semester. Similarly only those who have passed combined 1st & 2nd semester. and also 3rd semester are permitted to register for the 6th semester exam (Candidates admitted during 2006-2007 and 2007-2008 have been exempted from this as per G.O(Rt)No:1382/08 HEdn. dt 17/09/08).
4. **Instruction to the Candidates**
- 4.1 Candidates who have undergone the prescribed course satisfactorily in any one of the recognized Polytechnic Colleges in this State and who have secured the prescribed minimum attendance i.e.80% and above are eligible to appear for the Examination. However necessary condonation for the shortage in attendance can be obtained for valid reasons from the competent authority.
- 4.2 Application form for examination registration will be available in **the web site tekerala.org**. All Rev:03 and Rev:06 candidates are directed to use this application form for the online examination registration. All entries made by the candidate in the application form are to be carefully verified by themselves. After completing the online registration process take print out of the application and submit this application along with Chalan receipt/fee receipt to the principal for the confirmation of exam registration.
- 4.3 Candidates who have failed in the previous Examination need appear only for the failed subjects in the subsequent Examination. Such candidates should register for the subsequent Examination for all the subjects in which they have failed in the previous Examination.
- 4.4 **Piecemeal registration will not be allowed. Piecemeal appearance if any will be treated as cancelled and result will not be published.**
- 4.5 **The Change of Center will not be allowed. (See Para 14)**

5. **General Guidelines**

- 5.1 Principals of Polytechnic Colleges should verify whether the candidates have remitted adequate fee for all subjects in which he/she has failed (Details of fee is given in clause 6)with the list available **in the web site *tekerala.org*** for the acceptance of the Application.
- 5.2 Applications to appear for equivalent subjects from **Revised Scheme** and **Rev: 97** scheme candidates only be accepted. Applications of Old scheme and New Scheme candidates should not be accepted. Such registration, if any, will be invalid. True copies of SSLC & last previous mark list are to be attached along with the application and Chalan receipt/fee receipt, if any, so as to enable the Principal to verify the application of each candidate.
- 5.3 **There will be one more chance for the students under 2003 scheme to complete the exam.**
- 5.4 Applications of Revised scheme and Rev:97 scheme candidates should be forwarded with Nominal List in time, since they are to be allotted new Register Number. Applications of **Rev: 03** and **Rev: 06** students need not be forwarded to this office.

Fine will be collected for late applications, and will be paid in addition to above fees.

- **Students who are exempted from payment of fee and those who enjoy fee concession also should submit the application in the prescribed date. Such students also are liable to pay fine for late submission of application.**

7. **Last Dates of submission of Application /Remittance of fee**

The filled in application forms accompanied by recommendations of staff concerned and prescribed fees should be submitted to the Principal on or before the following dates.

- 7.1 The fee for the Examination should be remitted into a Government Treasury /in the State Bank of Travancore under the head of account **0202-02-101-98-Examination fees** or in the Polytechnic College Office.

- 7.2 Fee from the Regular candidates (Candidates in the roll of the Institution) appearing for the regular as well as supplementary exams may be collected by the Principals of the Polytechnic and remitted in the Treasury or State Bank of Travancore (Separate remittance may be made for each collection along with fine, if any) in the name of Principal and the original Chalan receipt forwarded along with the nominal list of candidates as given in para 8.
- 7.3 Private Candidates will have to remit the Examination fee in Govt. Treasury in the name of the candidates themselves by Chalan and the original Chalan receipt should be forwarded with the applications to the Principal of the Institution in which the candidate had undergone the course.
- 7.4 On no account the examination fee be sent to this office in cash or cheque or money order or postal order or in any form other than those prescribed above.
- 7.5 Amount of Examination fee once remitted will not be refunded or adjusted towards the fee for a subsequent Examination. The fee remitted prior to the date of this notification will not be accepted and need not be forwarded to this office.
- 7.6 Applications relating to those candidates who have remitted fee after the last date will not be accepted and need not be forwarded to this office.
- 7.7 The Principals of Polytechnic Colleges should remit the fee on or before the due date positively. The Collection of fee should be arranged in accordance with this.
8. **Date of receipt of Nominal list in the Office of the Controller**
Institution wise list of registered candidates will be available **in the web site *tekerala.org*** for scrutiny and verification. The Principals of Polytechnic Colleges should verify the application with the Chalan receipt/fee receipt for the acceptance of the Application before the date specified in the clause 7 . Only the Applications verified by the Principals will be accepted in this office. The principal should forward the list of candidates (hard copy) with the fees details remitted on or before 07/10/2009. Application form need not be forwarded to this office. Applications along with the B list are to be forwarded with the nominal list in the case of revised scheme and Rev:97 scheme students.
9. **If the withheld mark list if any, is not received in the Polytechnic office before the Prescribed date, FIVE DAYS grace time is allowed to remit the examination fee without fine from date of receipt of mark list in the institution.**
10. **Admission tickets of the candidates will be made available in the web site *tekerala.org* which is to be down loaded by the Principal and issued to the candidate with proper authentication and seal of Principal/Office.**
11. The rules now in force with regard to the realization of Examination fee from Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Educationally Backward Classes may be followed. The Principals of Polytechnic Colleges should get the amount reimbursed from the Harijan Welfare Department and remit into the Treasury under the Head of Account 0202-02-101-98-Examination fees, and forward the Chalan receipt to this office. List of concession holders in Branch wise (in duplicate copy) is to be forwarded along with the nominal list.
12. Online Application will be available in **the web site *tekerala.org*** .**Private candidates need not forward their application directly to this office.** They are to forward the applications with the original Chalan receipt so as to reach the Principals of the Institutions where they had undergone the course, before the dates specified in clause 7 above. **Principals should collect such applications and prepare the list in the proforma and forward the same to this office as given in para 8.**The Revised scheme and Rev:97 scheme students should use the separate application form prescribed for them.(see web site)

13. The Principals of the Polytechnic Colleges will scrutinize the applications and see that the entries made there in by the candidates are correct and agree with the records of the Institution.
14. Changes of Centre for the Examination will not be allowed to any candidate except for the candidate transferred from one Institution to another with the consent of the concerned authority. Others should write the Examination through the Center from where they had completed the prescribed course of studies.
15. **Cancellation of candidature for the Examination.**
“If a candidate desire to cancel his candidature for the Examination he/she should forward the applications duly recommended by the Principals of the Polytechnics so as to reach the office of the Controller of Technical Examinations, within 10 days after the completion of the last theory examination of that particular year Examination. Those who have applied for the Examination and absent without canceling their appearance will be treated as a chance. Cancellation of Candidature in Diploma Examination is allowed only once for a particular Year/Semester Examination”
16. **Issue of Mark list.**
Mark list will be issued to the candidates through the Principals of the Examination Center.
17. **Practical Examination.**
 - 17.1 Candidate should contact the Principal (Chief Superintendent) of the Centre in advance and ascertain from him the date fixed for the Practical Examination. If any candidate fails to contact the Principal in time and ascertain the date fixed for practical, this office will not take up the responsibility in the matter.
 - 17.2 The Chief Superintendent may fix the date of each Practical. Sufficient publicity should be given for the information of the candidate as regard to the date fixed for Practical Examination.
 - 17.3 Candidates who have failed only in Practical Examination and now appearing for the Practical should apply for admission to the Examination in the prescribed form.
18. Candidates appearing both for Theory and practical Examination should produce their admission tickets to the Examiner for Identification, on all days of Examinations.
19. **IMPROVEMENT.**
The students may apply for improvement of marks of 3rd/4th/5th Sem subjects (both Theory & Practical) They should appear for improvement in the next Examination after the regular chance (i.e. in the second chance). The higher marks will be counted for carry over of Second year mark along with the final year. Separate application should be submitted for improvement of passed subjects and supplementary appearance of failed subjects of 3rd/4th/5th Sem.
20. **Rules for the re-appearance of the Examination for betterment of result.**
The Candidate who passed in the Examination (Final Year/Sem Diploma Examination in Engg./ Technology) will be given the option to appear again for the same Diploma Examination in Engg./Technology as a full course candidate for the betterment of results within a period of one year from the date of passing the Final Year/Semester Examination. But no candidate shall be permitted for such reappearance for the betterment of result more than once. Such candidates need not surrender the Diploma already issued. If candidate submits application to appear for the Examination as per the above rules, a declaration of the candidates as given in the website, duly countersigned by the Head of the Institution should also be forwarded along with the applications.

21. The timetable for the written examination will be published in the Examination centers and in the web site.
22. Extra time up to 30 minutes per paper for all the papers of the Examination of 3 hours duration and proportionate time for the papers of shorter durations to physically handicapped candidates with 40% and above normal disability is sanctioned as per G.O.(MS) No.09/92/H.Edn dt:6.1.1992.
