ORDER

The Director of Technical Education vide his letter read as 1st paper above, proposed to award grace marks to the meritorious NCC Cadets of Polytechnic Colleges for the Diploma Examination in Engineering / Technology. Vide the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Deputy Director General, NCC has recommended the proposal. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to award grace marks to the NCC Cadets of Polytechnic Colleges for the Diploma Examination from the Academic Year 2006 – 07 onwards as detailed below.

- a) Cadets attending Republic Day Camp /Parade 5%
- b) Basic leadership camp (TSC) Nau Sainik 4%
Camp/Vayu Sainik Camp / Independence Day
Camp (Sports & Games at Delhi)
- c) 'C' Certificate holders 3%} only one of the Two
- d) 'B' Certificates holders 2%} .” .” .”
- e) Attending Centrally Organized Camps like
National Integration Camp, Trekking Camps,
Basic Leadership Camp, Advance leadership 2 %
Camp, Basic Mountaineering Course,
Advance Mountaineering Course, Skiing course.
- f) Attending Annul Training Camp (ATC) 1%
CATC, CAWATC.

The following shall be the guidelines for awarding grace marks.

1. Candidate should attend 75% of the NCC activities of a year.
2. Grace marks shall be given for all the theory papers subjects of a course in a year irrespective of whether the course as annual or semester.
3. In the case of both Semester courses and annual courses the academic year shall be taken into account. For Semester Course the percentage shall be the same as applicable to the annual scheme.
4. Grace marks shall be calculated on the basis of the aggregate marks of the year of participation and shall be awarded to the best advantage of the students to the theory paper in the respective year.
5. The student shall claim the grace marks before the end of the respective semesters within the academic year.
6. Grace marks shall be awarded only for the written Examination for the first appearance.
7. Grace marks awarded shall not be considered for ranking.
8. The maximum grace marks awarded to a student in a particular year is limited to 5% of aggregate marks.
9. Application with all relevant documents and attested copies of certificate for grace marks shall be submitted to the Director of Technical Education through the Principal, with the recommendation of the NCC officer of the concerned institution before the stipulated dates.

Cadets who appeared for the Examination of the Academic Year 2006 – 07 can claim the benefits of this Government Order within a period of six months from the date of this order in relaxation to the respective conditions of the Guidelines, shown above.
